Dr Srinivasan Ramani is Research Director, HP Labs India, located in Bangalore. He founded the National Centre for Software Technology (NCST) in 1985, and had directed it during 1985-2000. He made significant contributions to the creation and development of the Indian academic network, ERNET, which brought Internet connectivity to India in 1988, and the Bombay Library Network, Bonet.
