





#### • ETD Metadata Standard

- XML-encoded metadata standard (content and encoding) for Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETDs)
- -In part conforming to Dublin Core (DC)
- -Adds details about level, etc.

- With specified relationship to MARC
- Aim: Rich, high quality metadata

- Interoperability
- Standard for transferring metadata among digital libraries
  - -Protocol for Metadata Harvesting (PMH)
- NDLTD Union Catalog
